****SOAP Notes:**** Each session should be documented using Subjective, Objective, Assessment, and Plan format.

****Treatment Plans:**** Must be completed for all clients, outlining goals and interventions.

****Client Files:**** Keep all documentation up to date and in compliance with state regulations.

Insurance, Billing, & Reimbursement
